

TURKEY: POTENTIAL AND ONGOING PROJECTS

Implantation of Offshore Fish Farms

The project will be carried out in the frame of 2023 goals. Planned budget of the project is 2 bn dollars. Perch farm at Hatay, Turkish salmon farms at Trabzon, Giresun, Ordu, bivalves' farm at İzmir, Aydın, Çanakkale and around. The project aims to support local fish farming and fish export.

Turkey Milk, Meat, Food Industrialists and Producers Association-Improving Cold Chain Energy Efficiency Project

Project start date was September 2019 and duration is 36 months. The project aims to accelerate transforming energy efficiency opportunities into real investments by focusing on supply chains that include small and medium businesses in Europe.

DAINME - SME Dairy Innovation for Mediterranean SME

The purpose of the project is to improve the circular economy of milk and dairy small and mediumsized enterprises in Mediterranean countries. This goal will be achieved through the application of innovative technologies and the development of new valuable dairy products. Project start date, December 1, 2019.

Türkşeker (Turkish Sugar Factories Institution) Tenders

Türkşeker institution mainly controls the sugar industry in Turkey, which is a state subsidiary. Within 2021, several tenders containing of machines and raw material will be held. Tenders are published <u>here</u>.

Licensed Warehousing Project - TMO

The project initiated by government circular in 2005. It aims to decrease warehousing cost by providing modern, healthy and innovative warehousing standards to private and public sector agents. The project is carried out by the cooperation between Turkish Grain Board (TMO) and the Union of Chambers and Commodity Exchanges of Turkey (TOBB). The goal in the frame of 2023 goals is to attain 775 thousand tons capacity. The project contains the implementing of new warehouses and the licensing process of existing warehouses.

International Winter Wheat Improvement Program

The project is held by the Turkish Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry and the cooperation with The International Maize and Wheat Improvement Center (CIMMYT). The project aims to develop genetically more suitable new winter wheat grains.

Şanlıurfa Frozen Corn Production Facility

The project has been prepared by evaluating the development of the food sector in Şanlıurfa and market gap in the corn industry. The project aims to support both local development and employment. Projected investment need is approximatively 1 bn dollars.

Rangeland Rental Projects

Rangeland rental projects for improvement purpose are projected in New Economic Plan prepared by former Minister of Economy. Ex. Rangeland rental tender will be held for improvement purpose in Kayseri. Tender will take place in January 2021 and the rental duration will be maximum 25 years.

ATSO Agricultural Cluster Project 2018-2021

The project has been take into governmental support program in 2018 in order to enhance international competitiveness. The goal of the project is to improve the institutional capacities of companies operating in the fields of fertilizers, seeds, pesticides, biological control, saplings, greenhouse systems-equipment and irrigation systems in Antalya province of Turkey. 75% of project costs are covered by Turkish Ministry of Commerce.

Muğla Vegetable and Fruit Drying Plant

The project has been prepared by GEKA (South Aegean Development Agency) in 2018. Projected investment cost is 2 mn dollars. The project aims to support the dried vegetable and fruit sector by attracting the investment incentive in Muğla province of Turkey.
